- You may either bring your own kayak or rent a kayak.
- If you are renting a kayak, reserving your kayak rental is your next step after choosing this activity on the New York Birders Conference web site.
- We have arranged a non-profit price of \$49 per person for the private 2-hour rental of kayaks from Hudson River Rental. (Both one and two person kayaks are available.)

Other things to know

Hudson River Rental needs a minimum of at least 10 people renting a kayak. If conference signups have not reached that minimum by August 15, we will cancel this activity and the rental company has agreed to refund any participants that have signed up. Those who had chosen kayaking will then be allowed to select a different field trip.

If we have too many requests for the Sunday kayaking, then we will offer a second session on Saturday.
